

Award for Ian Beasy



Our [TTYG](#) Youth Leader, Ian Beasy has won a “making a difference” award from Lloyds/TSB. This is a national scheme and has been timed as part of the run up to the Olympics. Ian was recently presented with his award by former Olympic triple-jumper [Jonathan Edwards](#) at the Savoy Hotel in London.
